4	Day 4 Tashkorghan - Kashgar (by automobile)	 private transfer from Tashkorghan to Kashgar  breakfast, lunch  The Stone City Ruins, The Golden Grassland The Stone City Ruins, located in Tashkurgan Tajik Autonomous County in southwestern Xinjiang, China, date back to the Jin and Tang dynasties. The ruins include city walls, gates, temples, residential areas, and Qing Dynasty government buildings. The city walls, built with stone blocks or adobe, have a perimeter of 1285 meters and cover an area of 107,000 square meters. The Golden Grassland near Tashkurgan Tajik Autonomous County in Kashgar, Xinjiang, is a picturesque wetland area with a river, surrounded by mountains and colorful forests. The golden grasslands shimmer in the sunlight, with Mongolian yurts and herdsman adding to the scenic beauty.
5	Day 5 Kashgar	 breakfast, lunch  Dawa lake and desert, Kashgar Atush Heavenly Gate Canyon The lake Dawa means (healthcare or Good for health) local superstitious people used to believed that the lake "Good for Health" in Chinese named Dawahu, now the area co-invested by some lea-sure outdoor groups and the local tourism administration , made this area even more prosperous with local Uighur cultural activities (can be organized cultural show and camel safari) in the heart of desert , clients are both ride camel or by desert jeep taken into the sand dunes . The Atush Heavenly Gate Canyon Scenic Area in Kashgar, Xinjiang, is a magnificent natural landscape where cliffs on both sides stand steeply, forming a gateway-like scenery, hence its name "Heavenly Gate Canyon." Visitors can enjoy the spectacular canyon views here and experience the awe-inspiring work of nature.
